Note: Acrylic is more durable but can crack; (rounded corners will minimize cracking, but it can still happen. Lucent can be damaged if folded or creased; this includes the tabs, making the Cheetah clip a bit less durable, especially when masks are changed regularly.

Cheetah™ 1.0 Flexible Mask Clip Instructions

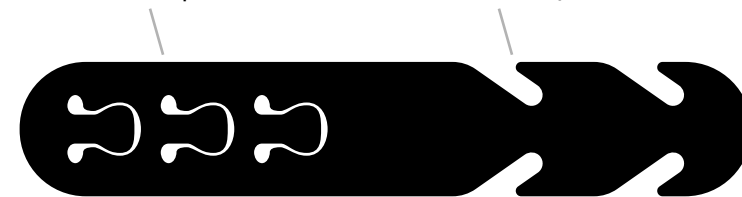
Before first use, remove masking if present
Clean with soap/disinfectant as necessary.



Mask straps can go around or under ears, whichever is more comfortable. You will have to experiment to find the best position for you from the six possibilities. The clip should hold the mask snugly but not dig into your neck.

1 The tabs are intended for permanent attachment to your mask. Be careful to avoid breaking any tabs while determining the best adjustment, then leave clip attached to mask. If you are cycling through multiple masks, use a different clip for each one.

2 To put mask on, hold clip in your non-dominant hand and opposite mask strap in your dominant hand. Put on mask, then attach strap to chosen slots. To remove mask, release strap from the slots only.



Note: On both sides, the part of the strap secured by the tab or between the sides of the slots should be underneath the clip (closer to your neck).

Clean with soap/disinfectant as necessary.



Mask straps can go around or under ears, whichever is more comfortable. You will have to experiment to find the best position for you from the four possibilities. The clip will be the most comfortable if the straps slightly off your neck.

1 To set up clip, insert strap into adaptable channel; you can choose the width you want at any time.

2 Most people find the clip a bit more comfortable with the center openings facing up.



3 Select the slot in the channel for the clip width you want. Move clip to back of head, then use your dominant hand to attach the second, fixed side. Don't pull mask and clip over head together as straps or clip may break.

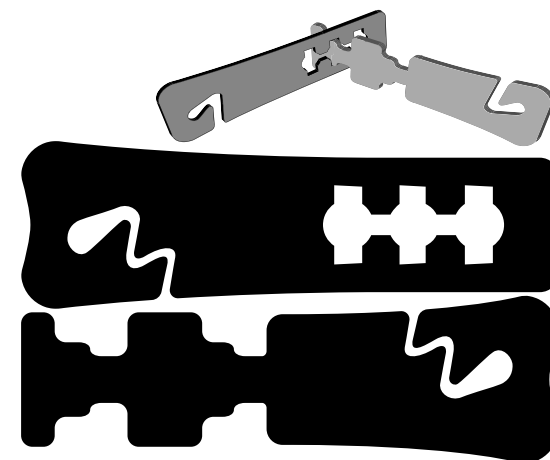

Mask straps can go around or under ears, whichever is more comfortable. You will have to experiment to find the best position for you from the six possibilities. The clip will be the most comfortable if the straps slightly off your neck.

1 To set up clip, insert the mask straps into the halves of the clip. Holding the tab half of the clip in your dominant hand, pull mask on and position the two halves behind your head.

2 Turn tab half of clip 90° and insert into the slot, turn back 90° and pull slightly to lock in your chosen adjustment. Don't pull mask and clip over head together as straps or clip may break.
